In the upcoming term of Critical Reading and Writing (term start date: Sun 2nd Dec), your child will be learning about precise expression of ideas in English texts. The level includes a critical look at details of punctuation, grammar and vocabulary to begin with. Then students learn how to apply this to their own reading and writing.

This term can be quite challenging to students who do not read or write much English outside of the classroom. In order to make good progress with this course, students should be encouraged to read more and to use English regularly in their spare time.

During this term, students will read extracts from two books about unusual adventures. If your child enjoys these, Lynne Reid Banks has written many popular children's books, and the *Rats of NIMH* series was continued by the author's daughter, Jane Leslie Conly.

Books we'll read extracts of in class this term:

The Indian in the Cupboard by Lynne Reid Banks Mrs Frisby and the Rats of NIMH by Robert C. O'Brien

Students can develop their writing skills using the ideas from this course by using the following recommended reference books:

How To Write Poems by Joseph Coelho *The Oxford Dictionary of Synonyms and Antonyms*
