In the upcoming term of Critical Reading and Writing (term start date: Sun 2nd Dec), your child will be reading a wide range of stories and poems related to social issues. These are excellent introductions to the deeper reading concepts of purpose and point of view. They also expose students to a wider range of stories than they typically read.

In order to be well-prepared for the challenging texts your child will encounter in secondary school, it is important to encourage them to read as widely as possible. In our classes this term, we will read extracts from a number of books. The authors of these have all written several other books, so you can encourage your child to explore more from the writers they like.

Books we'll read extracts of in class this term:

The Tale of Despereaux by Kate DiCamillo The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time by Mark Haddon* The White Tiger by Aravind Adiga* A Christmas Carol (adapted) by Charles Dickens Johnny Got His Gun by Dalton Trumbo* * Parts of this text may not be suitable for all readers; parents may want to read it first.

Other texts which cover social issues in an interesting and child-friendly way are:

Al Capone Does My Shirts by Gennifer Choldenko The Invention of Hugo Cabret by Brian Selznick The Wheel of Surya by Jamila Gavin

Some of these books are available for purchase at i-Learner and the rest can be found in bookstores and public libraries. Note: This term does **not** have a set reader.
