Dear Parents,

In the upcoming term of Critical Reading and Writing (term start date: Sun 2nd Dec), your child will be undertaking a comprehensive study of poetry. They will recap a broad range of literary techniques and then learn how to develop sophisticated answers on the effects of these.

In secondary school, students need to progress to giving answers which include a personal response to a poem (i.e. write about how the poem makes them *feel*). This can be very daunting to students who do not read much poetry. However, it is a skill which can be improved, and it's one that will get easier the more poems they read.

These books will be helpful and inspiring for students who want to broaden their exposure to poetry:

i-Learner Poetry Workbook – Daffodil level
The Girl of Ink & Stars by Kiran Millwood Hargrave
A Poem for Every Night of the Year edited by Allie Esiri

Some of these books are available for purchase at i-Learner and the rest can be found in bookstores and public libraries.
