# Unit 8

## Simple Present Tense: Negatives



Anna 吃了一粒藍莓，藍莓很酸！ Anna 說：「I does not like blueberries!」

聰明的媽媽很高興，說：「Anna 真厲害，懂得用 does 表達不喜歡！別忘了，I 後面要用 do。」 Anna 馬上說：「I do not like blueberries!」

媽媽高興地笑了，她讓 Anna 每天也讀一下這個：

I do not.	They do.	It does not.	She does not.
You do.	We do.	You do not.	He does not.

**Use:** ❖ to talk about **facts and habits in negatives**

**Keywords:** every day, always, sometimes, usually, etc.

**For all verbs:**

Subject	Form
He / She / It	<b>does not (doesn't) + verb</b>
I / You / We / They	<b>do not (don't) + verb</b>

**Examples:** I **don't eat** sweets.

She **doesn't eat** lollipops.

## Simple Present Tense: Negatives

For the verb 'to be':

Subject	Form
He / She / It	is not (isn't)
I	am not ('m not)
You / We / They	are not (aren't)

**Examples:** He **isn't** my brother.  
I **am** not a singer.  
They **aren't** tired.
