Use: to talk about facts and habits in negatives

Keywords: every day, always, sometimes, usually, etc.

For all verbs:

Subject	Form
He / She / It	does not (doesn't) + verb
I / You / We / They	do not (don't) + verb

Examples: I don't eat sweets. She doesn't eat lollipops.

Simple Present Tense: Negatives

For the verb 'to be':

Form
is not (isn't)
am not ('m not)
are not (aren't)

Examples: He isn't my brother. I am not a singer. They aren't tired.
