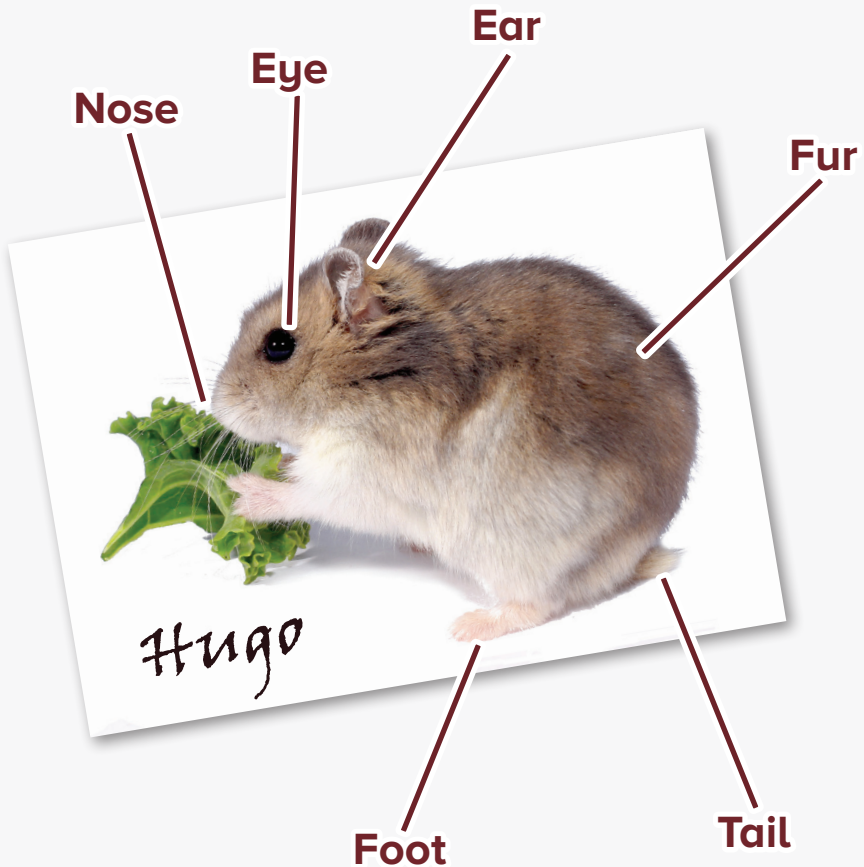


Hugo the Hamster

Hugo loves to eat seeds and fruit.



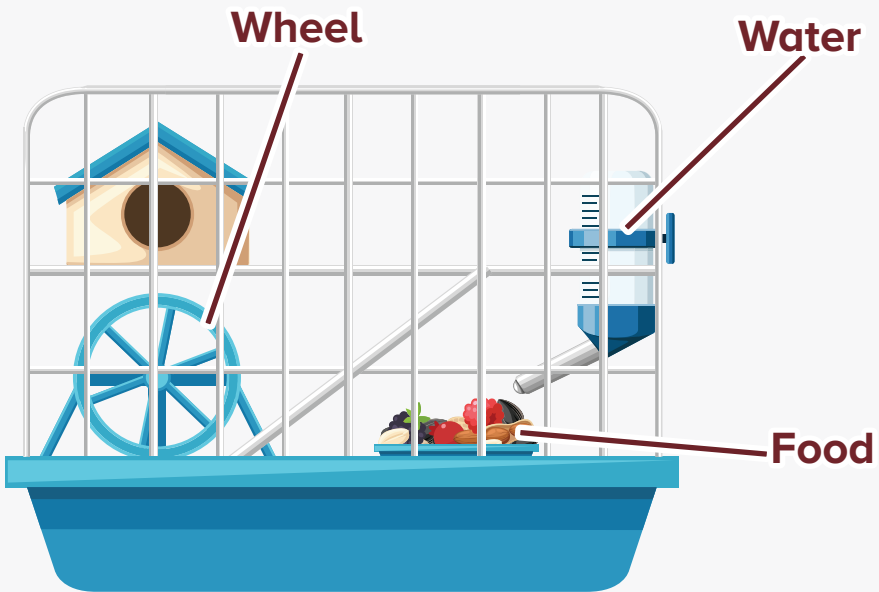
