We need a waiter

Do you love food and people?

The names of jobs often end in 'er'. The job name tells us what people do. For example, a painter paints. Look at these examples from the job advertisements.

- Baker = a person who **bakes** bread and cakes
- Driver = a person who **drives** cars, buses or trains
- Waiter = a person who **waits** at tables



Meatball World is a restaurant. There are three new jobs there. Each job needs you to do different things.



Learning in Action: Milk Art

There are lots of jobs! We need to know different things for different jobs. This can be very surprising.

Paints are made of chemicals. Artists need to understand them, so they are scientists too.

Let's paint in milk and learn about science.



Washing-up liquid

Drop food colouring on the milk. Touch the food colouring with washing-up liquid.

When we wash our hands, soap breaks up the oil. The washing-up liquid does this to the milk (full fat milk works best!).
